

JQuiz: multiplechoice answers

Type a title for your exercise into the Title box. Next to Q1, type your question or you can also add a picture. To insert a picture click on the icon on the menu bar and find the picture you want for this activity.



The picture will not appear, only the code. Now add the 4 possible answers in the A-B-C-D gaps and tick the correct answer. You can add more answers if you want, to do so, click on the upward arrow next to the word answer. If you insert pictures, make sure you save all the pictures in a folder and you also save your quiz in the folder, e.g. Qhaus. To add question 2, click on the upward arrow next to Q1. Add as many questions as you want and once you have finished the activity, save the project again by selecting **File > Save as >** (find the file name) **Save** and then create the activity by clicking on the spider web with the 6 icon on the tools bar.



Click on this icon on the menu bar to change the look of your quiz.

****You can also add a timer to the activity. Click on the 'configuration' icon (see below) and choose 'timer'.**

****Edit and add feedback, appearance and button using the 'configuration' tool.**

****You can insert a link to another file or a website: go to 'insert' > 'link'.**

Extra:

****You can also insert a recording or a video: go to insert> media object > click on add window media player > go to browse and find your file. You can change the size of the video or the play button for your recording.**

Other types of quizzes:

You can also change the type of quiz by clicking on the down arrow menu next to the question.

1. Multiple choice: choose the correct answer
2. Short-answer: pupils need to type the correct word / sentence
3. Hybrid: first it is a short-answer question, if pupils fail to do it correctly, it becomes a multiple choice question.
4. Multi-select: more than one answer can be correct
